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MINUTES OF THE 42nd ANNUAL GENERAL BODY MEETING HELD

ON 20/11/2022 AT OUR BUNTARA BHAVANA, BANER, PUNE - 411045.

The meeting has begun with lighting the lamp along with devotional prayer songs & subsequently offered condolences for all the family members of our community who had lost their loved ones by observing a minute's silence.

1. Meeting was called to order by president at 11 am sharp. Thereafter the meeting had been adjourned for an hour for want of quorum. At 12 pm, again President Santosh V Shetty had called the adjourned meeting to order and welcomed all the members for said meeting. The President, VPs, Secretary, Treasurer, Chairperson LW, Chairman of both regional committees, Chairman of YW were at the podium. The attendance sheet of the meeting annexed is annexed in Annexure-1.

2. Secretary Ajith Hegde read out the minutes of the last AGM held on 20/11/2022 and the same was approved by the house unanimously. Proposed by Narayan Hegde, Seconded by Prasanna Shetty.

3. With regard to secretarial report, Ajith Hegde informed in brief, the details of various activities & events under taken by the main Sangha, Ladies Wing, Youth Wing, & regional committees during the year from last AGM 2019 to this AGM 2021 & also mentioned that more details were given separately in the AGM 2022 report under the head "secretary report'. He thanked all members for their contributions in making all these events successful during the year 2021-22.

4. Treasurer, Mr.Srinivas Shetty presented the audited Balance Sheet, Income & Expenditure A/C of 2021-22 & various other annual reports for approval & adoption. And also informed that these reports were already circulated with AGM-2022 reports. In addition, he also mentioned about the total money received as donations, expenditure on movable & immovable properties, expenditure on objects of the trust like annual picnic, annual Sports, annual get together, education aids etc in detail. After thorough discussion & deliberations, house accepted all of them unanimously.

The house felt that there is no need for changing the auditor and it was unanimously passed as follows:

At the same time, he extended his heartfelt gratitude to all members of main com., LW, regional com., YW & others for their help & contribution in successful completion of his 1st year of present tenure, He expressed his sincere gratitude to all those who supported & cooperated directly or indirectly for successful completion of all activities of this year.

7. Since no other issues were raised in the house, the meeting was adjourned with vote of Thanks by Secretary Ajith Hegde & concluded with national anthem, followed by non vegetarian buffet lunch.

Subject: Audit Engagement Letter for the financial year 2022-2023

You have requested us that we audit the financial statements of the Trust as defined in Maharashtra Public Trust Act,1950 for the financial year beginning April 1, 2022 and ending March 31, 2023. We are pleased to confirm our acceptance and our understanding of this audit engagement by means of this letter.

I. STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

A. ABOUT THE TRUST

BUNTS' SANGHA, PUNE is a public charitable trust domiciled in India and incorporated under the provisions of Maharashtra Public Trust Act, 1950. The trust is also registered under Section 12A of the Income Tax Act, 1961.

Its main objectives of the trust are as under

- 1. The Sangha shall mainly direct its efforts towards the educational and cultural improvement of the Bunts in the city of Pune.
- 2. To help the poor and deserving students to pursue their studies.
- 3. To establish and maintain schools and/or colleges reading rooms, libraries and/or any other activities directly or indirectly to promote education and /or knowledge in any field.
- 4. To foster a spirit of brotherhood, co-operation, sacrifice, initiative and service amongst the people.
- 5. To render such other help or service to its members in particular and people in general.

B. BASIS FOR PREPARATION OF FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

The Financial Statements are prepared under historical cost convention in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles in India. All income and expenditure having material bearing on the Financial Statements are recognized on an accrual basis except contribution payable to the Charity Commissioner which is accounted on payment basis. The preparation of Financial Statements requires the Management to make certain estimates and assumptions considered in the reported amounts of Assets and Liabilities (including Contingent liabilities) as on the date of the Financial Statements and the reported income and expenses during the reported period. The Management believes that the estimates used in preparation of the Financial Statements are prudent and reasonable. Actual results could differ from these estimates. Any changes in such estimates are recognized prospectively.

Further, the Trust is a Small and Medium Sized non corporate entity (SMC) as per ICAI announcement dated 31st March, 2021. Accordingly, the Trust has complied with the Accounting Standards as applicable to SMC only for the items which are material in nature

C. USE OF ESTIMATES

The preparation of financial statements are in conformity with the generally accepted accounting principles requires the management to make judgments, estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of revenues, expenses, assets and liabilities and the disclosure of contingent liabilities, at the end of the reporting period. Although these estimates are based on the Management's best knowledge of current events and actions, uncertainty about these assumptions and estimates could result in the outcomes requiring a material adjustment to the carrying amounts of assets and liabilities in future periods.

D. FIXED ASSETS & DEPRECIATION

Tangible Fixed Assets are stated at their original cost of acquisition including taxes, duties, freight and other incidental expenses relating to the acquisition and installation of the concerned assets less depreciation.

Deprecation is provided on fixed assets at rates prescribed in the Income Tax Rules on "Diminishing Balance Method".

Intangible assets acquired are capitalized at the acquisition price and is amortised over economic useful life of the asset.

Advances paid towards the acquisition of Property Plant and Equipment

Advances paid towards the acquisition of Property, Plant and Equipment, outstanding at each balance sheet date are shown under capital advances. The cost of the Property, Plant and Equipment not ready for its intended use on such date is disclosed under capital-work inprogress.

E. IMPAIRMENT OF ASSETS

The carrying amounts of assets are reviewed at each balance sheet date if there is any indication of impairment based on internal/external factors. An impairment loss is recognized wherever the carrying amount of an asset exceeds its recoverable amount. The recoverable amount is the greater of the assets' net selling price and value in use. In assessing value in use, the estimated future cash flows are discounted to their present value at the weighted average cost of capital.

After impairment, depreciation/amortization is provided on the revised carrying amount of the asset over its remaining useful life.

F. REVENUE RECOGNITION

Revenue is recognized to the extent that it is probable that the economic benefits will flow to the trust and the revenue can be reliably measured.

Community hall charges receipts are accounted on the basis of invoices raised for the usage of the hall and recognized net of Goods & Service Tax collected separately.

a. Interest income on Bank fixed deposits is recognized on a time proportion accrual basis taking into account the amount outstanding and the rate applicable.

- b. Donation income is recognized on receipt basis.
- c. All other income is recognized on an accrual basis.

G. GOVERNMENT GRANTS

Grants and subsidies from the government are recognized when there is reasonable assurance that

- (i) the Entity will comply with the conditions attached to them, and
- (ii) the grant/subsidy will be received.

When the grant or subsidy related to revenue, it is recognized as income on a systematic basis in the Profit and Loss Account over the periods necessary to match them with the related costs, which they are intended to compensate.

Where the grant is related to an asset the grant is shown as a deduction from the gross value of the asset concerned in arriving at its book value. The grant is thus recognized in the profit and loss statement over the useful life of a depreciable asset by way of a reduced depreciation charge

When the Entity receives non-monetary grants, the asset is accounted for on the basis of its acquisition cost. In case a non-monetary asset is given free of cost, it is recognized at a nominal value.

Government grants of the nature of promoters' contribution are credited to capital account and treated as a part of the Partners Funds / Capital.

H. BORROWING COSTS

Incurred for the Purchase of the Property, Plant and Equipment

Borrowing cost includes interest, amortization of ancillary costs incurred in connection with the arrangement of borrowings and exchange differences arising from foreign currency borrowings to the extent they are regarded as an adjustment to the interest cost.

Borrowing costs that are directly attributable to the acquisition, construction or production of an asset that takes a substantial period of time to get ready for its intended use are capitalized. All other borrowing costs are recognized as expenditure in the period in which they are incurred.

I. EXPENSES

Expenses are accounted on accrual basis and provisions are made for all known liabilities and losses based on available information.

J. CONTRIBUTION TO EARMARKED FUNDS

Contribution received with a specific direction towards earmarked funds like Life Membership Fees Fund, Building Fund, Education Fund, Patrons Fund, Kalpvruksha Yojana Fund etc. is credited to the respective Fund account and treated as corpus of the trust. Interest received on the investment made is credited to the respective Fund account. Withdrawals made from the respective Fund Account as per the object of the Fund is debited to the respective Fund account to the extent of available information.

K. INVESTMENTS

Investments are recognized at actual cost including cost incidental to acquisition, if any. Investments include long term fixed deposits with various banks. Investments include the accrued interest receivable and credited as interest income in Income and Expenditure Account.

L. FOREIGN CURRENCY TRANSACTIONS

Transactions in foreign currencies are recorded at the exchange rate in force at the time of occurrence of the transactions.

Exchange differences arising on the settlement of revenue transactions are recognized in the Income and Expenditure Account.

M. INCOME TAX

Current Income Tax is measured at the amount expected to be paid to the tax authorities considering the exemptions available under sections 11 and 12 of the Income Tax Act . Deferred Tax Assets and Deferred tax Liabilities, if any, is not recognized in the books of accounts.

N. COMPARATIVES

Comparative financial reporting is presented in accordance with the 'Corresponding Figure' financial reporting framework set out in auditing and assurance standard 25 on "Comparatives'. Accordingly amount and other disclosures for the preceding year are included as an integral part of the current year financial statement, and are to be read in relation to the amounts and other disclosures relating to the current year.

O. CONTINGENT LIABILITIES, PROVISIONS AND CONTINGENT ASSETS

The Entity creates a provision when there is present obligation as a result of a past event that probably requires an outflow of resources and a reliable estimate can be made of the amount of obligation.

"A provision is recognized when an entity has a present obligation as a result of past event and it is probable that an outflow of resources will be required to settle the obligation, in respect of which a reliable estimate can be made. Provisions are not discounted to its present value and are determined based on management estimate required to settle the obligation at the balance sheet date. These are reviewed at each balance sheet date and adjusted to reflect the current management estimates. Contingent Liabilities are disclosed when the entity has a possible obligation or a present obligation and it is probable that a cash outflow will not be required to settle the obligation. " A disclosure for a contingent liability is made when there is a possible obligation or a present obligation that probably will not require an outflow of resources or where a reliable estimate of the obligation cannot be made.

Contingent assets are neither recorded nor disclosed in the financial statements

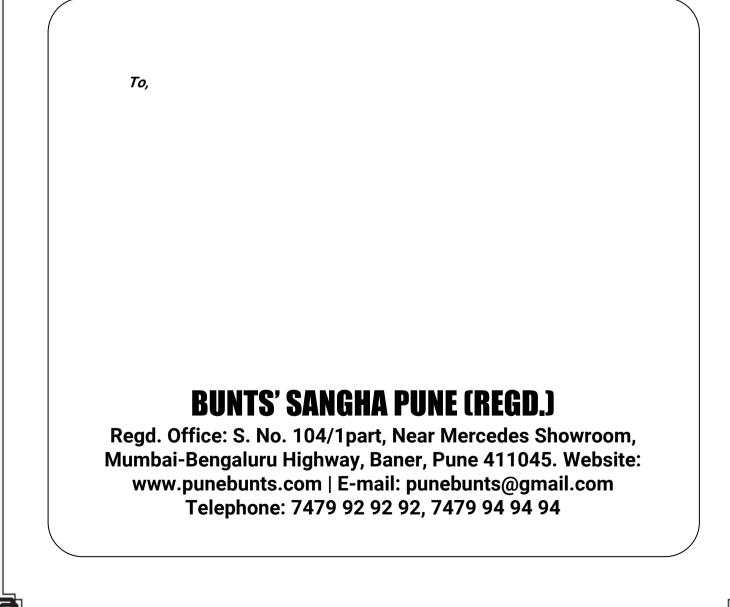
